## HP Officejet 7610 Wide Format e-All-in-One Printer

The HP Officejet 7610 Wide Format e-All-in-One is a new addition to HP's lineup of wide format printers, offering print, scan, fax and copy capabilities across versatile media formats. The printer produces professional-quality marketing materials at a low cost per page in sizes from  $3 \times 5$  in  $(76 \times 127 \text{ mm})$  to  $13 \times 19$  in  $(330 \times 483 \text{ mm})$  for less than a print shop. With the introduction of the unit, businesses can create high quality borderless flyers, brochures and more in-house with the full benefits of a multi-function printer.

The HP Officejet 7610 Wide Format e-All-in-One Printer features:

- Print, copy, scan, and fax capabilities in sizes up to 13X19 inches/A3+.
- Print at speeds up to 33 ppm black, and up to 29 ppm color.
- Ability to print from virtually anywhere using HP ePrint, <sup>(7)</sup> and connect directly to the printer without a router with HP wireless direct printing. <sup>(8)</sup>
- HP pigment inks for water resistant and smudge free prints.
- Recommended monthly print volume of up to 800 pages and a duty cycle of up to 12,000 pages per month. (5,6)
- Reload paper less often and handle large print jobs using the automatic document feeder and 250-sheet paper tray.
- Save up to 50 percent on paper costs with optional two-sided printing, and get free cartridge recycling through HP Planet Partners. (9,10)
